The 6th World University Shooting Sport Championship will be organized by the Organizing Committee of the WUC Shooting Sport 2016 in Bydgoszcz, Poland, under the Honorary Patronage of the Members of the Honorary Committee. The list of the members of the Honorary Committee is as follows:

Furthermore, the WUC Shooting Sport is also organized under the auspices of the International University Sports Federation (FISU) in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the appropriate FSIs unless stated otherwise by the Executive Committee.

VENUES

The sport facilities are placed in the “Zawisza Sport Club” area and the Garrison Shooting Range in Bydgoszcz. The distance between the two shooting ranges at which the competition takes place amounts to 4 km and the journey takes about 10 minutes. The main shooting range is located at No. 163, Gdańska Street, where the rifle and pistol competitions take place. However, the second shooting range is located at Rynkowska Street, where the contestants compete in the shotgun disciplines.

ACCOMMODATION & CATERING

Participants of the 6th World University Shooting Sport Championship 2016 are accommodated in single and double rooms of the following hotels: Hotel Brda, Hotel Maraton, Hotel Campanile, Hotel Ratuszowy, Hotel Zawisza.

All the delegations will have their breakfast at the place of their accommodation. Dinner and supper, however, will be served in the Zawisza Hotel. Breakfast and supper will be served in buffet style.



TRANSPORT

All officials and teams should notify the Organizing Committee in advance, as to their arrival dates, times, and flight schedules, so that transportation arrangement can be made both to and from the international airports.

OC will provide transport between the airports and the place of accommodation according to the arrival/departure schedule of the delegations. The transport of the participants will be monitored by the members of the OC at airports based upon the information provided in advance regarding arrivals/departures.

Transport to/from sport venues:

There will be five special bus lines arranged for the Championship purposes which will transport the participants to the sport venues and the hotels. Moreover, municipal public transport in Bydgoszcz will be provided for free for all the participants of the WUC Shooting Sport Championship from 14th to 18th September 2016.

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

The Shooting Sport event shall be organized in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) unless otherwise stated by the Executive Committee. In the event of a disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.

The program and duration of competitions are fixed by the Executive Committee in agreement with the Organizing Committee and the CTI. The competitions shall last five (5) days and include the following events:

Rifle Discipline

Events for Men

50 m Rifle Prone Men (60 shots)
50 m Rifle 3 Positions Men (3x40 shots)
10 m Air Rifle Men (60 shots)

Events for Women

50 m Rifle Prone Women (60 shots)
50 m Rifle 3 Positions Women (3x20 shots)
10 m Air Rifle Women (40 shots)

Pistol Discipline

Events for Men

50 m Pistol Men (60 shots)
10 m Air Pistol Men (60 shots)
25 m Rapid Fire Pistol Men (60 shots)
25 m Standard Pistol Men (3 x 20 shots)

Events for Women

25 m Pistol Women (30 + 30 shots)
10 m Air Pistol Women (40 shots)

Shotgun Discipline

Events for Men

Skeet Men (125 Target)
Trap Men (125 Target)
Double Trap Men (150 Target)

Events for Women

Skeet Women (75 Target)
Trap Women (75 Target)



Each country may enter a maximum of forty-two (42) persons: thirty-six (36) competitors and six (6) officials.

Individual Events

Rifle Discipline

Events for Men, Women:

A maximum of five (5) competitors per discipline but no more than three (3) competitors in each particular event.

Pistol Discipline

Events for Men:

A maximum of seven (7) competitors but no more than three (3) competitors in each particular event;

Events for Women

A maximum of four (4) competitors but no more than three (3) competitors in each particular event;

Shotgun Discipline

Events for Men

A maximum of nine (9) competitors per discipline but no more than three (3) competitors in each particular event;

Events for Women

A maximum of six (6) competitors per discipline but no more than three (3) competitors in each particular event.

Team Events

Three (3) competitors per team in each particular event.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.

The team composition shall be confirmed at the General Technical Meeting or at the latest 48 hours before the discipline starts.



SHOTGUN AMMUNITION

International brands of the shotgun ammunition, such as RC4 and Fiocchi Golden, will be available at the shooting range. The price of one box of the shotgun ammunition amounts to **7 €**.

TRAINING FEE

7 € – Unofficial Training Fee per round Trap/Skeet/Double Trap

Please note that the official trainings are free of charge.

PARTICIPATION FEE

For each member of the delegation the fee amounts to €70 per day for a maximum of 36 members of one delegation (maximum 6 officials) . For additional members of the delegation the fee amounts to €95 per day per person.

25% of the accommodation costs have to be paid one month prior arrival, the rest must be paid upon arrival.

Fees may be paid in cash (Euro only) or by credit card at the venue.

Each delegation must have insurance for all members of its team. This must cover life insurance, medical insurance, public liability, property and travel insurance.
